LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No 08(T) OF 2019

TEMPORARY NAVIGATIONAL MARK CHANGES COWES EASTERN CHANNEL

Notice is hereby given that due to the current reconfiguration of the new Eastern Channel the following temporary navigational marks changes are in affect:

1. Work is still underway to remove the Small Craft Channel navigational marks as per chart BA2793 and position new marks for the new dredged Eastern Channel.
2. The east cardinal (VQ(3)5s) in pos 50° 45.985'N 001° 17.542'W off the eastern end of the Breakwater has been substituted with a yellow special mark (Fl.Y.4s)
3. A temporary south cardinal (Q Fl. 6 + LFl) has been placed in approx. pos 50° 45.800'N 001° 17.668'W
4. The red lateral mark in 50° 45.891'N 001° 17.527'W is currently unlit and does not form part of the new eastern channel.

All vessels are to navigate with particular caution whilst in the vicinity of the new Eastern Channel.

This Cowes Harbour Commission Local Notice to Mariners will be in force until further notice.
