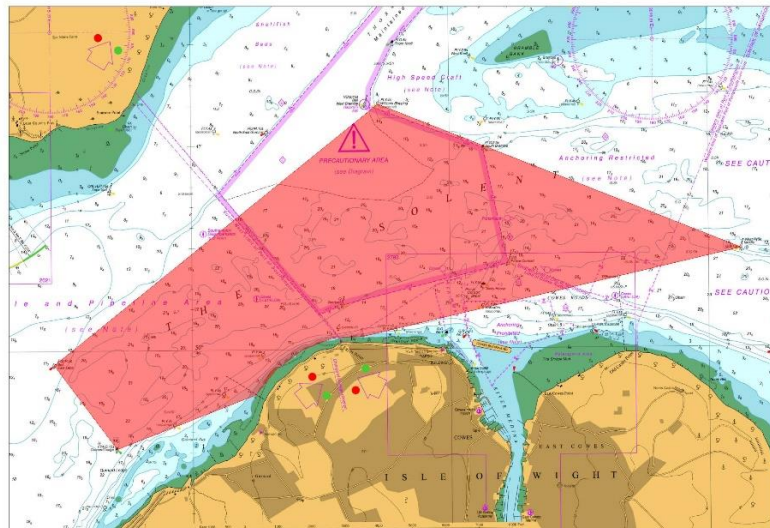
### LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 24(T) of 2019

### King's Cup Competition 8<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> August 2019

*This Notice shall remain in force until 10<sup>th</sup> August 2019*

**Notice is hereby given** that the **King's Cup** competition will take place on **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> and Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2019**. This Notice should be read in conjunction with No. 25(T) of 2019 "SailGP Foiling Catamarans Racing Regatta".

The King's Cup Charity Sailing Event is a high profile short match racing series involving eight 'Fast 40+' yachts. The courses will be kept simple and based around Egypt Point with the area of sailing bounded by East Lepe, Gurnard Ledge, West Ryde Middle and the Williams Shipping race mark (see Figure 1).

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> August will be a practise day. On Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August, there will be three 30-minute races starting at 1000. All starts will be from the Royal Yacht Squadron Line. There are expected to be a large number of vessels in attendance including the race competitors and spectator craft. All mariners are advised to navigate in the area with extreme caution.
