LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 27(T) of 2019

Submerged Mooring Buoys

Notice is hereby given that the six westernmost mooring buoys positioned approximately 100 metres off the shore to the west of the entrance to Cowes Harbour are submerged from **two hours before High Water until Low Water**.

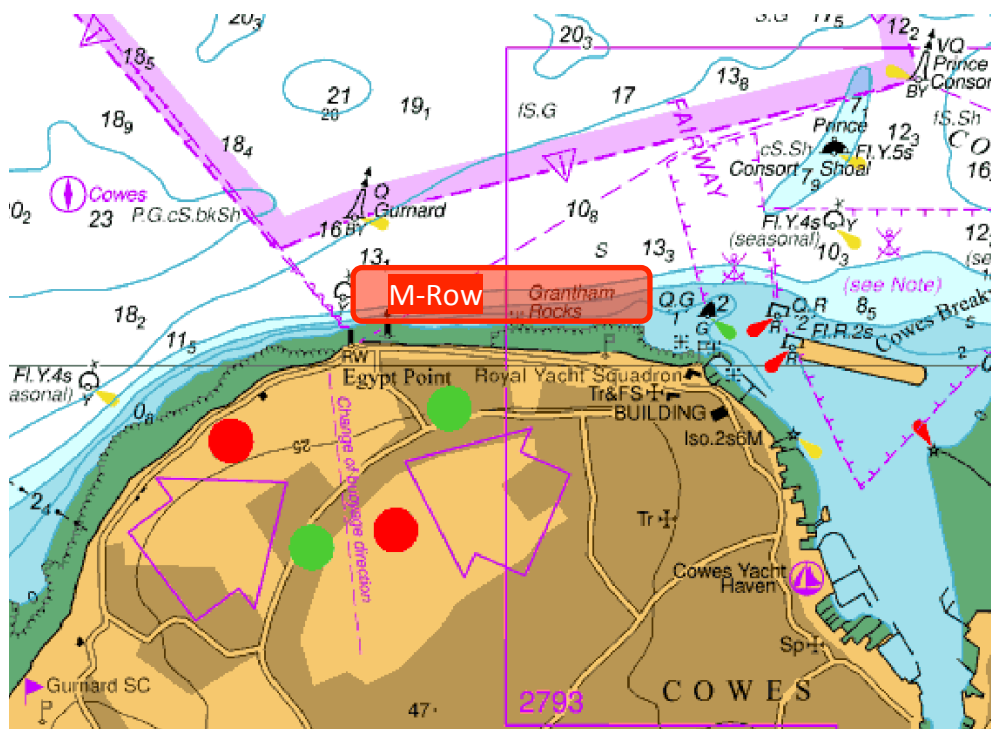


Figure 1: Location of M-Row mooring buoys

The buoys are part of a row of ten mooring buoys known as 'M-Row'. **The location of the western end of M-row is 50° 46'.100 N, 001° 18'.870 W. The location of the eastern end of M-row is 50° 46'.131 N, 001° 18'.147 W (see figure 1 below).**
